Can I have a lodger or run a business from my home?





This leaflet explains the permission required to share your home with someone or to run a business from your home.



Lodgers and subletting

Not everyone is eligible to take in a lodger or subtenant and you must have our permission.

Can I take in a lodger?

With permission if you have the following types of tenancy:

- Assured
- Secure

Permission will not be granted if you:

- · Live in supported housing
- · Live in a sheltered scheme
- Want to sublet the whole of your home
- If your home is overcrowded or will become overcrowded by taking in a lodger.

Does this include my family and partner?

Family members and partners who live with you as part of your household are not normally considered lodgers.

Permission is still needed for a new partner and any other family member where there are changes to your original tenancy agreement.

Remember any form of subletting breaches your tenancy agreement

Running a business from home

You need to have our permission to run a business from your home.

How to ask for permission

Once we receive your application we will need to consider:

- Any impact these changes may have on your neighbours
- Health and safety and / or building regulations
- Your rent account balance
- Your tenancy and the type of tenancy you have with us

Remember any income generated from your home may affect your benefits or Universal Credit claims.
